Minutes of the October, 2019 meeting were approved by voice vote, as well as the treasurer's report.

Doug Trogstad was thanked for picking up the doughnuts for the meeting. The Ladies Club will be providing the doughnut next month due to their loss to us in last years Men's vs Ladies contest.

Mike Johnston is recommending a change in our by-laws, Part 1, Section 2 allowing AGYC employees with golf privileges to join the Men's Club. His proposal would allow We will vote on this By-Law change at our June meeting.

Gerry Cassel invited everyone to join the new Hickory/Old Club event on Sunday, May 2nd in the afternoon. If you don't have old clubs, some will be available to you that day.

Captain Mike Lambert reviewed some upcoming events:

- The Brook Cup begins April 1 and continues thru September 30. The top 24 money winners will compete in the Brook Cup on October 9th.
- The Travelers Prize Pot has also begun. We have 6 travel events scheduled this year. You must play in 4 of these and pay the extra \$5 fee to the clubhouse to participate. The lowest 4 net scores will count. You must have a minimum of 1 of your scores from an away Men's Club scheduled event. You can count 1, 2, 3, or all 4 of your scores from an away event.
- New this year on Wednesdays will be an optional KP side pot. You pay \$2 to the Clubhouse and you are entered in either the Blue/green or green tee KP contest. Winners will receive a Cash prize. There must be a minimum of 5 participants in each category.
- The sign-up for the Home and Home with Lakeland Village for May is not posted on the bulletin board.
- The Alderbrook Challenge will begin in June. At our regular monthly meeting, 2 pre-determined holes will be selected during the months of June, July, August, and September (for a total of 8 holes). The winner will be the lowest net score on these 8 holes. This is a free event to all members.
- Pace of play - be sure to keep up with the group ahead of you.
- Sand bottles - please carry a sand bottle and repair your divots. Also fix all ball marks on the greens. The rakes are also back in use so please fix the sand after hitting out of the traps.
- The 50/50 ticket was selected. Keep the ticket for a free drink after the round today only.

Pro Shop (Sam) report:

- Pace of play - Stay up with the group ahead of you.
- When turning in a scorecard, be sure to put your first and last name and which tees you played from.
- Holes #9 and # 12 lips coming out of the sand traps are being fixed. They are ground under repair now so you are allowed a free drop.
- You are allowed to lift and rake the sand under your ball if needed.
- Winter rules are: in the fairway you can move you ball one club length no closer to the hole. In the rough, you may move your ball 6 inches.
- The men's club has a no "gimme" putt philosophy. Putt everything out.
