

Men's Club Minutes
September 1, 2021

The meeting was opened by President Mike Johnston at 8:17 am

There were no new members present to introduce.

The minutes and treasurers report of the August meeting were passed on voice vote.

Mike reminded the group that aeration would begin on September 7th and highlighted an away game at Indian summer Golf Course on Wednesday, September 8th for \$65, plus a \$17 fee for a cart if required.

The Housing and Facilities Committee is looking for members. By the way, the Men's Club purchased blinds (\$500) for the clubhouse with the money we receive from selling bricks in front and in back of the clubhouse. In addition, the new playfield that is being constructed at the wickiup needed some assistance and the Men's Club purchased retaining wall bricks to keep the filler material under the equipment. This cost us \$700.

Mike Johnston highlighted the Greens Committee minutes. The committee is considering renovation of the 18th hole. There is a plan to look at eliminating the first water hazard near the green with a sand trap, installing a lining on the remaining water hazard, and also looking at redoing the green.

Mark Maxfield highlighted the first Golf Committee meeting held in July. The role of the committee is the facilitation of the course from the players point of view. Many ideas have been considered and they are listed in the September issue of the Foremast. All club members are invited to attend the Greens and Golf Committee meetings. The Golf Committee's next meeting is the 2nd Tuesday of October at 3:00 pm.

The Officer's nomination sheet has been posted on the bulletin board for those people interested in serving the Men's Club in a leadership capacity. Elections will be held at the October Mens Club Meeting.
